**Saint Patrick's day's hat**

- 1- On a dark green sheet of paper, draw 2 circles. 
- 2- Cut out the big circle. 
- 3- Cut out the small circle. 
- 4- On a light green sheet of paper, draw 2 lines. 
- 5- Cut tabs in every 2 centimetres 
- 6- Fold the tabs. 
- 7- Form a cylinder with the light green sheet. 
- 8- Stick the tabs under the circle to make the hat. 
- 9- Stick the small circle on the top of the hat. 
- 10- You can decorate your hat with a green belt and a gold buckle : 
- 11 - You can draw clovers and irish flags.
