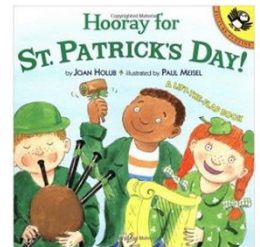
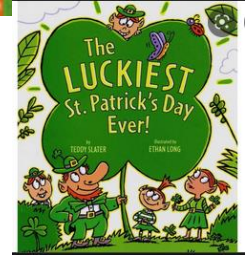
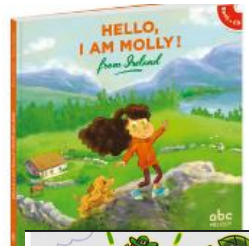

Saint Patrick's day's hat

1- On a dark green sheet of paper, draw 2 circles.

2- Cut out the big circle.

3- Cut out the small circle.

4- On a light green sheet of paper, draw 2 lines.

5- Cut tabs in every 2 centimetres

6- Fold the tabs.

7- Form a cylinder with the light green sheet.

8- Stick the tabs under the circle to make the hat.

9- Stick the small circle on the top of the hat.

10- You can decorate your hat with a green belt and a gold buckle :

11 - You can draw clovers and irish flags.
